#### Resolution

Motion by Jordan, second by Neely to approve the following resolution:

## Resolution #UCC2013-01

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of January, 2013, Northern Natural Gas Company, a Delaware Corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Northern," filed with this Board an Application for Permission to Maintain and Operate Natural Gas Pipelines in, across, through and under certain County Roads in Union County, South Dakota, as more particularly described in such Application and attachment "A" and depicted on the plats attached thereto: and

WHEREAS, after due investigation and consideration, this Board finds that in the interest of public convenience and welfare, the permission in said Application should be granted.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that permission for the following ten years is hereby granted to Northern, its lessees, successors and assigns to operate, maintain, repair and remove, in whole or in part, natural gas pipelines, in across, through and under those County Roads in Union County, South Dakota, for which application was duly made.

This permission is granted upon the condition that:

Northern will indemnify, save and hold harmless said Board of County Commissioners of Union County, South Dakota, from any and all liability for damages arising from the operation, maintenance, repair or removal of said pipelines;

- (1) Both parties understand that this resolution does not supersede Union County permit requirements. Northern Natural Gas agrees to continue to request and follow the Utility Permit process established and managed by the Union County Public Works Administrator. Northern Natural Gas shall acquire a permit prior to the placement of any new utility being placed across, through and under or alongside any County Roads.
- (2) It will maintain, operate, repair and remove such pipelines in, across, through and under said County Roads so as not to unreasonably interfere with, obstruct, endanger or impede traffic upon said County Roads.
- (3) Northern Natural Gas agrees that in the event it is deemed necessary by the Union County Board of Commissioners to move or alter these lines in any way due to maintenance of highway reconstruction, the alteration will be accomplished by the owner without cost to Union County.

The permission granted hereby shall cancel and supersede the permission heretofore granted to Northern Natural Gas Company by Resolution dated February 18, 2003, maintain and operate natural gas pipelines in, across, through and under the County Roads in Union County, South Dakota.

## <u>Highway</u>

PWA Roggow met with the board to discuss various matters.

Motion by Jordan, second by Neely to approve the following resolution:

Resolution #HD2013-01

WHEREAS, seasonal climatic changes can be detrimental to our highways, and,

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of County Commissioners desires to protect existing Union County Highways, ultimately saving tax dollars, and,

WHEREAS, South Dakota Codified Laws 32-14-6 allows for the reduction of the legal weight limit, which may be carried upon highways within Union County,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that certain Union County Highways be restricted to a load limit of 7 tons per axle imposed on trucks, trailers, and wagons. The Union County Highway Superintendent will cause to be installed adequate warning signs notifying the traveling public of the load weight restrictions on the restricted highways, and that the restrictions will be in force upon the placing of such signs, and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the penalty for the violation of the load restrictions shall be as set forth in SDCL 32-22-55.

# Striping agreement

Motion by Jordan, second by Schempp to sign an agreement with the State of South Dakota to provide for the striping of county roads within Union County and for their continuing maintenance. The state has allocated \$500,000 to a state-wide county highway striping project designated as project number P 000S(00) PCN 01XN referred to as "PROJECT", STATE funds to pay for 60% of PROJECT cost up to a maximum of \$500,000 with COUNTY funds to pay remainder of PROJECT costs. Union County will be included in the PROJECT for the striping of approximately 102.5 miles of County roads at an estimated cost of \$83,879.80. (County's share-\$61,652.92) Carried.
