The Union County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on January 20, 2015, at the Courthouse in Elk Point, SD at 8:30 a.m.

Motion by Headid, second by Schempp to approve the agenda as amended. Carried.

Motion by Karpen, second by Ballard to approve the minutes from January 6, 2015 as presented. Carried.

Travel Authorization

Motion by Karpen, second by Ballard to approve the travel authorization for Nurse secretary Rumi Weigl to attend a workshop in Sioux Falls on March 19- WIC will be reimbursing all expenses. Motion carried.

Executive Session

Motion by Karpen, second by Schempp to enter executive session at 8:47 a.m.to discuss personnel. Carried. Chairman declared the board out of executive session at 9:00 a.m.

Travel Authorization

Motion by Karpen, second by Schempp to accept the resignation of weed board member, Jeff Horner, effective January 30, 2015. Carried.

Motion by Karpen, second by Ballard for indigent and personnel at 9:11 a.m. Carried. Chairman declared the board out of executive session at 10:09.

Recess

Chairman declared a recess at 10:10 until 10:15.

Sheriff

Sheriff Limoges and Chief Jailer Sara Hight met with the board for discussion of transportation officers and PT Jailers. Motion by Headid, second by Karpen to hire up to 2 additional part-time jailers to eliminate over-time hours and maintain the current PT employees at less than 20 hours per week. Carried.

<u>Telephone</u>

Darcy Burner and Ryan Zanter from Quality Telecommunications met with the board to discuss the telephone bid they presented. The committee reviewed the options and then made a recommendation to the board to accept the bid from Quality Telecommunications.
