Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Gary Wilson, 50, South Sioux City, NE, was sentenced on November 8, 2010, in the 1st Circuit Court, in Union County, to one count of possession of a controlled substance (Valium), a class 4 felony. Wilson received a Suspended Imposition of Sentence on this charge. Therefore, if Wilson completes his 5 years of supervised probation without a major probation violation, Wilson's record will be sealed and no sentence will be imposed. As a term of Mr. Wilson's probation, he will have to obey all laws; not possess or use an illegal or controlled substance; can not consume alcohol during his probation; and Wilson must submit to a search of his person, car, home, blood or urine at the request of law enforcement or his probation officer. Wilson was also fined \$1000 as a term of his probation.

Gary Wilson was driving a commercial motor vehicle on Interstate 29 on July 13, 2010 when Mr. Wilson bypassed the South Dakota Port Of Entry. Trooper Trent Heuertz, with the South Dakota Highway Patrol, stopped Mr. Wilson for bypassing the scale and found the controlled substance in Mr. Wilson's possession.
