Long-term Recovery Team Meetings Set in Lincoln, Union Counties

CANTON, S.D. – The Lincoln-Union Long-term Recovery Team is hosting two additional public meetings to reach out to any residents of the two counties who have unmet needs after the June flooding.

"We want to be sure we are reaching everyone who may need help in the recovery process after our devastating flood event," said Steve Ziebarth, co-chair of the recovery team. "We also want to make sure everyone understands the process of long-term recovery.

Both meetings will be Tuesday, Sept. 2, 2014. The Lincoln County meeting is at the Senior Citizens Center in Canton from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. The Union County meeting is in the community room of the Union County Courthouse in Elk Point from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

The meetings are for any resident with unmet needs who has not talked with a case manager and any other resident with questions about the long-term recovery process. Ziebarth and Kari Elrod are co-chairs of the recovery team.
