Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Brandon Murray, a 21 year old Sioux Falls, SD resident, was sentenced on May 21, 2012 on a probation violation on his original charge of third degree burglary, a class 4 felony. The Court revoked Murray's suspended imposition of sentence and sentences him to five years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary with one year being suspended and credit for one-hundred and twenty-three days previously served. The Court also ordered that Murray was to pay all of his financial obligations as a term of satisfying his parole.

Brandon Murray was brought before the court for violating his supervised probation. He admitted to possessing or using alcohol or controlled drugs or substances; and failing to make regular payments as ordered by the court.
