Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Corey Steeg, a 36 year old man from Sioux City, IA plead guilty on May 21, 2012 to one count of Possession of Controlled Substance, a class 4 felony and one count Driving with a Revoked License, a class 1 misdemeanor. Steeg was sentenced on June 25, 2012. For the charge of Possession of Controlled Substance, Steeg received a seven (7) year sentence to the South Dakota State Penitentiary with seven (7) years suspended. The Court then placed Steeg on five (5) years of supervised probation. Additionally, Steeg received a sixty (60) day sentence to the Union County Jail. For the charge of Driving with a Revoked License, Steeg received a fine of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars.

This case was investigated by Officer Eric Fay of the North Sioux City Police Department. On January 3, 2013, Officer Eric Fay initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle which Steeg was driving. During the stop, Officer Fay discovered that Steeg was driving with a revoked Iowa license. Steeg admitted that they had just come from Mr. Yuks and had just purchased synthetic marijuana for the purpose of smoking the substance. Steeg also admitted that he had consumed synthetic marijuana about two weeks prior. Steeg tested positive for having consumed methamphetamine.
