Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Kim Gilkyson, a 57 year old Vermillion, SD resident plead guilty on November 28, 2011, and was sentenced in the 1<sup>st</sup> Circuit Court, in Union County on January 30, 2012 to one count of Driving Under the Influence 3<sup>rd</sup> offense, a class 6 felony. The maximum sentence on the class 6 felony is two (2) years in the penitentiary and / or a four-thousand dollar (\$4,000) fine. Gilkyson received a sentence of two (2) years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary with two (2) years suspended. Gilkyson was placed on supervised probation for three (3) years and ordered to spend one-hundred (100) days in the Union County Jail. Gilkyson was also fined \$1000 on the DWI 3<sup>rd</sup> charge. Gilkyson's driver's license was revoked for two (2) years from the date of his release.

Kim Gilkyson, was a observed weaving within his own lane on Interstate 29 by South Dakota Highway Patrolman, Cody Jansen. Gilkyson's blood-alcohol content was .206. This was Gilkyson's third DUI conviction in ten years and his fifth career DUI conviction.
