Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Ryan Cournoyer, a 31 year old Sioux Falls, SD resident, was sentenced on March 12, 2012 on a probation violation on his original charge of passing a check against a nonexistent account, a class 5 felony. The Court allowed Cournoyer to keep his suspended imposition of sentence and was placed back on probation for eighteen months. The Court also ordered that Cournoyer was to pay all of his financial obligations by September 12, 2012.

Ryan Cournoyer was brought before the court for violating his supervised probation. He admitted to missing six meeting in a one year time frame; moving without informing his probation officer; and failing to make regular payments as ordered by the court. Cournoyer, was ordered to spend fourteen days in the Union County Jail prior to being release on probation.
