Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Junna Killscrow, a 27 year old Sioux City, IA resident, admitted to four counts of violating the terms of her probation. Ms. Killscrow was on probation from an original conviction of possession of a controlled substance, namely methamphetamine. Based on this original conviction and sentencing from July 6, 2012, Ms. Killscrow received the following sentence as a result of Killscrow's admission to the probation violations: Killscrow was re-sentenced to a seven year suspended execution of sentence with an order to serve seven years of supervised probation.

At a probation violation hearing on April 30, 2013, Ms. Killscrow was found to have used and admitted to the use of methamphetamine in May and July of 2013. Killscrow also failed to complete and work on obtaining her GED. Additionally, Killscrow failed to complete the court ordered chemical dependence treatment or even start the treatment within thirty days from starting her probation after her original term of confinement in the Union County Jail. And finally, Ms. Killscrow failed to make her court ordered monthly payments of \$20.00 per month. There were no charges for the two occasions in which Killscrow either admitted to the use of or was tested and found to have continued to use a felony substance known as methamphetamine. This is Killscrow's first probation violation on her first felony conviction.
