Case Synopsis:

On November 28, 2015, Alcester police received information that David Foux was growing marijuana in an Alcester residence. This resulted in a search warrant for the residence which revealed a marijuana grow operation. Foux admitted to growing marijuana inside the residence, which was occupied by his four small children, and located within the Alcester Public School zone.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana the court sentenced Foux to 360 days in the Union County jail with 330 days suspended and that Foux pay to Union County \$84.00 Court costs; \$230.00 Prosecution Costs; \$250.00 Fine; \$680.80 Court Appointed Attorneys Fees.

On the four charges of Contributory Abuse or Neglect the court sentenced Foux to 360 days in the Union County Jail with 330 days suspended for each charge. The court also required Foux pay to Union County \$336.00 court costs and fines in the amount of \$400.00.

Jail time is to be served concurrently.

Criminal History Synopsis:

This was a felony case against David Foux that was plead down to five class 1 misdemeanor convictions.
