Surplus Cash Report

To be in compliance with SDCL 7-21-18.1, it is required to publish in the minutes the total unassigned fund balance of the general fund of the county as of March 31 and September 30. This amount may not exceed 40% of the total amount of all general fund appropriations contained in the budget for the next fiscal year. As of March 31, 2012, Union County has \$2,050,510.96 in undesignated funds. This figure is 33.17% of the 2012 General Fund Budget.
