Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Dustin Oberg, 19, Alcester, SD, was sentenced on October 25, 2010, in the 1st Circuit Court, in Union County, to one count of first degree burglary, a class 2 felony and one count of Sexual Contact, a class 1 misdemeanor. Oberg received a sentence of 15 years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary with 11 years suspended on the charge of first degree burglary. Oberg received a suspended sentence of 1 year in the Union County Jail on the sexual contact charge. These two sentences stems from the November 20, 2009 burglary of a rural Union County home south of Beresford, SD, and the sexual assault of the occupant of that residence.

This case was investigated by Chief Deputy Mike Bucholz of the Union County Sheriff's Office. This case was prosecuted by Deputy Attorney General Bridget Mayer and Union County State's Attorney Jerry Miller.
