Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Dustin Oberg, 19, Alcester, SD, plead guilty on August 30, 2010, in the 1st Circuit Court, in Union County, to one count of first degree burglary, a class 2 felony and one count of Sexual Contact, a class 1 misdemeanor. The burglary charge carries a maximum sentence of 25 years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary and or a fine of \$50,000. The sexual contact charge carries a maximum sentence of 1 year in the county jail and or a fine of \$2,000.

Today's plea stems from the November 20, 2009 burglary of a rural Union County home south of Beresford, SD, and the sexual assault of the occupant of that residence. Sentencing in this case has been scheduled for October 25, 2010, at 10:30 a.m.

This case was investigated by Chief Deputy Mike Bucholz of the Union County Sheriff's Office. This case was prosecuted by Deputy Attorney General Bridget Mayer and Union County State's Attorney Jerry Miller.
