Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Gerald Clay, 20, Sioux City, IA, Admitted on September 20, 2010, to violating the terms and conditions of his probation on or prior to March, 2010. Clay was sentenced in the 1<sup>st</sup> Circuit Court, in Union County on September 20, 2010, for the probation violation. Clay's underlying felony charge was first degree escape. Clay originally received a suspended sentence of 5 years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary with a 3 year requirement for supervised probation.

Clay was re-sentenced on his probation violations on September 20, 2010, and received a suspended sentence of 5 years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary with a 3 year requirement for supervised probation. Clay was also sentenced to an additional 60 days in the Union County Jail and suspends any of these days if the defendant is directly admitted into a drug treatment facility. Clay was also required to pay his outstanding monetary obligations and all new monetary obligations.
