### Press Release - For Immediate Release

Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Jolene White, 43, Dakota Dunes, SD, plead guilty on August 16, 2010, and was sentenced in the 1<sup>st</sup> Circuit Court, in Union County on October 29, 2010, to one count of Driving Under the Influence 3<sup>rd</sup> offense, a class 6 felony. The maximum sentence on the class 6 felony is 2 years in the penitentiary and / or \$4,000 fine. White received a sentence of 2 years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary with 2 years suspended. White was also sentenced to 60 days in the Union County Jail with educational and treatment release; fined \$1000; and placed on supervised probation for the next 3 years. White's driver's license was suspended 2 years from the date of her release.

Jolene White was a reported to Law Enforcement as person who had nearly hit another vehicle. Sgt. James Heeren of the North Sioux City Police Department found the vehicle driven by White, which was swerving beyond its lane of travel - Southbound on Sioux Point Road. White was found to be under the influence at a level of .309% BAC.
