Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Kalen Hahn, 29, Harrisburg, SD, plead guilty on May 13, 2010, and was sentenced in the 1<sup>st</sup> Circuit Court, in Union County on June 28, 2010, to one count of Driving Under the Influence 4<sup>th</sup> offense, a class 5 felony. The maximum sentence on the class 5 felony is 4 years in the penitentiary and / or \$8,000 fine. Hahn received a sentence of 5 years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary with 30 months suspended. Hahn was also fined \$1000 on the DWI 4<sup>th</sup> charge, with his other costs and obligation amounting to \$1675.64. Hahn's driver's license was suspended 2 years from the date of his release.

Kalen Hahn, was a reported on 4/13/10, to law enforcement that he was driving all over the road - northbound on Interstate 29. Hahn was found to be under the influence at a level of .208% and driving without a valid license while on parole for a DWI 3rd. This case was investigated by South Dakota Highway Patrol officer Trooper Chris Halm.
