Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Kevin Markee, age 19, from North Sioux City SD, admitted to his first probation violation since being sentenced on December 20, 2010 on one count of second degree burglary (a class 3 felony). The court's disposition in this felony probation file to revoke Markee's suspended imposition of sentence and enter a judgment and conviction on this file with a ten year sentence with seven years suspended to the state penitentiary.

Markee's original conviction stemmed from a burglary of a residence of a relative. Markee was given a week to get his affairs in order prior to turning himself into the jail to start his original sentence, when he was arrested for driving while under the influence (2nd offense). Markee plead to the new charge of driving while under the influence and admitted to his probation violation. Markee is being held until he is transported to state penitentiary by the Union County Sheriff.

The original case was investigated by Sgt. Richard Headid with the North Sioux City Police Department.
