Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Renee Krumvieda, 27, North Sioux City, SD, was sentenced on October 4, 2010, in the 1st Circuit Court, in Union County, on the following charges:

Krumvieda was sentenced on one count of Second Degree Burglary, a class 1 felony due to the Defendant being a habitual offender. Krumvieda was given a 20 year sentence to the South Dakota State penitentiary with all but 6 ½ years suspended.

Krumvieda was sentenced on a second count of Second Degree Burglary, a class 1 felony due to the Defendant being a habitual offender. Krumvieda was given a 20 year sentence to the South Dakota State penitentiary with all but 6 ½ years suspended.

Krumvieda was sentenced on one count of possession of controlled substances, a class 2 felony due to the Defendant being a habitual offender. Krumvieda was given a 20 year sentence to the South Dakota State penitentiary with all but 3 ¼ years suspended.

All of the above sentences are to run concurrent with each other. As Krumvieda also plead to the additional charge of being a habitual offender, every charge is increased by two levels increasing her maximum potential sentence. Krumvieda will be eligible for parole in 58 ½ months. Krumvieda was under investigation for breaking into her neighbor's residence on multiple occasions. She confessed to Sgt. Richard Headid of the North Sioux Police Department, who was investigating these burglaries that occurred in March of 2010.
