Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Taras James Michels, 41, North Sioux City, SD, plead guilty today in the 1st Circuit Court during his scheduled arraignment hearing to one count of first degree rape, a class C felony, and to one count of aggravated incest, a class 3 felony. The maximum sentence on a class C felony charge is life imprisonment without the possibility of parole and / or a fine of \$50,000 with a mandatory minimum sentence of 15 years. The maximum sentence on a class 3 felony is an additional 15 years in the penitentiary and / or a fine of \$30,000.

Michels was indicted on January 25, 2011 on the above listed charges. Today's plea stems from the rape of a child under the age of thirteen and an act of incest with a 16 year old child. Michels remains in the custody of the Union County Jail without bond.

A sentencing date has not been set at this time. This case was investigated by Chief Deputy Mike Bucholz with the Union County Sheriff's Office.
