Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Brandi Robinson, a 25 year old woman from North Sioux City, SD plead guilty on November 28, 2011 to one count of possession of a controlled substance, a class 4 felony. Robinson was sentenced on February 6, 2012. Robinson received a seven (7) year sentence to the South Dakota State Penitentiary with all seven (7) years suspended. The Court then placed Robinson on seven (7) years of supervised probation. Additionally, Robinson received a sentence of one-hundred and thirty-four (134) days to the Union County Jail and a five-hundred dollar (\$500) fine.

This case was investigated by officer Aaron Tyler of the North Sioux City Police Department. On September 28, 2011 law enforcement was called to Robinson's residence for a noise complaint. While addressing the noise complaint, Robinson's boyfriend admitted to the officer that there was drug paraphernalia in the home. Consent to search Robinson's residence was given and pursuant to further investigation, it was discovered that prescription morphine was being abused and distributed.
