### Press Release - For Immediate Release

Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Darrell Marlow, a 53 year old man from Sioux Falls, SD, admitted to violating his supervised probation at a court hearing on February 6, 2012. Marlow admitted to violating his probation in the following manner: Marlow failed to register as sex offender at his place of residence as required by state law. Marlow was charged in Minnehaha County, plead guilty, and was sentenced on the class 6 felony of failing to update the sex offender registry. Marlow was brought to Union County following the completion of his Minnehaha County jail sentence to address his probation violation.

Marlow was sentenced on February 6, 2012 as a result of his admission to violating his supervised probation. The court sentenced Marlow to two (2) days in the Union County Jail and gave Marlow two (2) days credit for the time he spent incarcerated on the probation violation. The Court ordered Marlow to pay his court appointed attorney fees, and advised that Marlow's probation would expire on February 10, 2012.

Marlow originally plead in March of 1997 to one count of Sexual Contact with a Child Under the Age of Sixteen, a class 3 felony. At that time, Marlow received a suspended fifteen (15) year sentence to the South Dakota State Penitentiary and was placed on supervised probation for fifteen (15) years on February 10, 1997. At that time, Marlow was ordered to serve six (6) months in the Union County Jail with work release.
