Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Glenn Miller, a 36 year old Sioux City, IA resident, was sentenced on August 20, 2012 on one count of possession of controlled substance (Methamphetamine), a class 4 felony and one count of driving with a suspended license. Miller received a five (5) year sentence to the state penitentiary and suspended two (2) years of that sentence. Miller was taken into custody and transported to the state penitentiary at the Sheriff's earliest convenience. Miller was ordered to pay no fine on the felony and \$200.00 fine on the driving with a suspended license. Miller was also ordered to pay the city of North Sioux City \$1895.00 in restitution for the damage to city property stemming from the Miller's hit and run accident prior to being stopped.

Sergeant James Heeren of the North Sioux City Police Department initiated a traffic stop on a suspect vehicle that had left the scene of an accident which caused \$1895.00 of damage to city property. The Iowa driver, Glenn Miller, was driving while suspended. Miller admitted to smoking marijuana 2 days before the accident. The passenger, Aimee Johnson, also a suspended driver from Iowa admitted to smoking marijuana 2 days before the accident. A urine test revealed that Miller had recently possessed and consumed Methamphetamine, Hydrocodone, and marijuana and those substances were still present in his body.

This conviction appears to be Miller's fourth career felony conviction.
