### Press Release - For Immediate Release

Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller announced today that Jared Jolin, a 21 year old Sioux City, IA resident, admitted to violating his supervised felony probation at a court hearing on February 27, 2012. Originally Jolin received a suspended ten year sentence to the state penitentiary. Jolin's probation stemmed from a 2009 felony charge for second degree burglary, a class three felony. At that time, Jolin was placed on supervised probation for five years.

Jolin's probation violation stemmed from a December 28, 2011, while he was arrested for possession of marijuana based upon his admissions and a search of the vehicle. Jolin's urine test revealed that he had consumed Hydrocodone recently without the benefit of a prescription. Jolin's sentence on March 12, 2012 for his probation violation consisted of a ten year suspended sentence to the state penitentiary with Jolin being placed on supervised probation for ten years. Jolin was also sentenced to one-hundred and eighty days in the Union County Jail with credit for the seventy-four days he spent incarcerated awaiting sentencing. Jolin's probation and county jail time is to run concurrent with his felony possession of controlled substance. The balance of the county jail sentence will be suspended when Jolin can enroll in a treatment program. Officer Aaron Tyler of the North Sioux City Police Department was the investigating officer on this traffic stop.
