### Press Release - For Immediate Release

Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller announced today that Jared Jolin, a 21 year old Sioux City, IA resident, plead guilty on February 27, 2012 in the 1<sup>st</sup> Circuit Court to one count of Possession of a Controlled Substance, a class four felony. The maximum sentence on a class four felony charge is a fine up to twenty thousand dollars, or a sentence up to ten years in the South Dakota State Penitentiary, or both.

Jolin was sentenced on March 12, 2012 on the charge of possession of a controlled substance. Jolin received a ten year sentence to the state penitentiary with all ten of those years suspended and placed on supervised probation for ten years. This sentence is to be consecutive to Jolin's sentence he received for his probation violation stemming from his 2009 second degree burglary charge. Jolin also received a sentence of one-hundred and eighty days in the Union County Jail with credit for the seventy-four days he spent incarcerated awaiting sentencing. Jolin's probation and county jail time is to run concurrent with his felony second degree burglary sentence from the probation violation. The balance of the county jail sentence will be suspended when Jolin can enroll in a treatment program.

On or about December 28, 2011, Jolin, a passenger in a motor vehicle, was arrested for possession of marijuana based upon admissions and a search of the vehicle. Jolin's urine test revealed that he had consumed Hydrocodone recently without the benefit of a prescription. Officer Aaron Tyler of the North Sioux City Police Department was the investigating officer on this traffic stop.
