### Press Release - For Immediate Release

Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Jesse Brubaker, a 29 year old Sioux City, IA resident was sentenced on October 15, 2012 on the following charge(s): one count of possession of controlled substance (Methamphetamine), a class four felony; one count of driving with a suspended license, a class two misdemeanor; and one count of failure to comply with law enforcement, a class two misdemeanor.

Brubaker received a five year sentence to the state penitentiary on the possession of controlled substance charge. The court suspended two of the five years upon conditions that Brubaker needs to satisfy and cooperate with his treatment and paying his obligations. On the controlled substance charge, Brubaker is required to pay Court Costs of one hundred and four dollars; Prosecution Costs of one hundred and fifty-four dollars; restitution in the amount of eighty-five dollars to North Sioux City; and court-appointed attorney fees in the amount of eight hundred and thirty dollars and ninety-three cents.

On the driving with a suspended license charge, Brubaker is required to pay Court Costs of sixty-six dollars; and a fine in the amount of one hundred dollars.

On the failure to comply with law enforcement charge, Brubaker is required to pay Court Costs of sixty-six dollars; and a fine of one hundred dollars; and restitution in the amount of eighty-five dollars to North Sioux City. Brubaker had retained his own counsel.

On March 9, 2012, Brubaker was traveling in North Sioux City at night with no taillights and speeding. North Sioux City police officer Aaron Tyler, stopped Brubaker who failed to follow the officer's commands. Brubaker attempted to flee on foot. Brubaker was driving a friend's vehicle of which he did not know and his license was suspended out of Iowa. This conviction is Brubaker's third felony conviction.
