### Case Synopsis:

Gormly was originally stopped because the vehicle he was driving had expired license plates. Gormly was found to be under the influence and found to have a blood alcohol content of .247 %. Gormly also was cited for driving with a suspended driver's license.

### Sentencing Synopsis:

Gormly's was sentenced to a suspended two year sentence to the state penitentiary. The Court further ordered that Gormly would be on supervised probation for three years. Gormly was also ordered to spend ten days in the Union County Jail. Additionally, Gormly was ordered to pay all fines, costs and court-appointed attorney fees.

### Criminal History Synopsis:

This is Mr. Gormly's second career felony conviction. Gormly was convicted for Possession of a controlled substance, a class D felony in a Johnson County Court in Iowa on October 15, 2011.
