Case Synopsis:

Coyle was associated with a van that sometimes has Iowa plates on it and then sits without plates parked in North Sioux City. Coyle admitted to taking the plates off the vehicle and putting them back on when she needed to drive the vehicle. The plates that Coyle were using were expired and Coyle was also found to be a suspended driver. Coyle consented to the search of her purse which produced drug paraphernalia. Coyle consented to provide a urine sample that tested positive for Cocaine/Benzylecgonine at 340 ng/ml; Methamphetamine at 174,000 ng/ml; and Amphetamine at 29,000 ng/ml.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of possession of a Possession of a schedule I or II controlled substance charge, Coyle was sentenced to a suspended five year sentence. The Court sentenced Coyle to serve five year sentence of supervised probation. The Court further sentenced Coyle to eighty-three days in the Union County Jail with twenty-three days credit for the days served prior to sentencing. The Court further ordered that Coyle pay all fines, court costs, prosecution costs, and court-appointed attorney fees.

Criminal History Synopsis:

This is Ms. Coyle's third career felony conviction.
