Case Synopsis:

Herring was the driver of a vehicle that made a left hand turn from the right lane. Herring was found to not have a valid driver's license. A search of the vehicle yielded the possession of methamphetamine in a purse. Herring was in the vehicle with Tonya Rhymer and Bruce Solomon whom all denied using any controlled substances. Each of the occupants consented to provide a urine sample and each tested positive for a controlled substance. Specifically, Coyle's urine sample tested positive for Methadone at 1,100 ng/ml; Methamphetamine at 9,300 ng/ml; Amphetamine at 1,400 ng/ml; and Marijuana at 28 ng/ml.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of possession of a Possession of a schedule I or II controlled substance charge, Herring received a suspended imposition of sentence. The Court sentenced Herring to serve four years of supervised probation. The Court further sentenced Herring to ninety-eight days in the Union County Jail with ninety-eight days credit for the days served prior to sentencing. The Court further ordered that Herring pay all fines, court costs, prosecution costs, and court-appointed attorney fees.

Criminal History Synopsis:

This is Ms. Herring's first felony conviction.
