Case Synopsis:

On October 19, 2013, Thomas Supri, was the passenger of a vehicle that abruptly stopped on highway 105 while the officer was watching the vehicle. The driver then started to back up in its lane of traffic. Officer Tyler stopped the vehicle. The driver was searched and a knife was found. The driver consented to a search of the vehicle in which methamphetamine was found. Supri admitted that the methamphetamine was his. Supri provided a urine sample, which tested positive for the following: Methamphetamine at 4,200 ng/ml; Amphetamine at 570 ng/ml; and Marijuana (THC) at 31ng/ml.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of possession of controlled substance, the Court sentenced Supri to a suspended five-year sentence with five years of supervised probation. Supri was ordered to serve sixty days in the Union County Jail. The Court further ordered that Supri must pay all, restitution, fines, court costs, prosecution costs, and court-appointed attorney fees as a term and condition of satisfying probation.

Criminal History Synopsis:

This is Supri second career felony.
