Case Synopsis:

This case was originally investigated by Officer Eric Fay of the North Sioux City Police Department. On January 3, 2013, Officer Eric Fay initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle which Steeg was driving. During the stop, Officer Fay discovered that Steeg was driving with a revoked Iowa license. Steeg admitted that they had just come from Mr. Yuks and had just purchased synthetic marijuana for the purpose of smoking the substance. Steeg also admitted that he had consumed synthetic marijuana about two weeks prior. Steeg tested positive for having consumed methamphetamine.

Case Synopsis of Probation Violation # 1:

On July 10, 2014 during a home visit by his Iowa Court Services Officer, Steeg was found to be in possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia, and was subsequently arrested by the Sioux City Police Department and charged with Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Methamphetamines, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. On June 27, 2014, Steeg was observed by his CSO, drinking beer at Bud's Bar in Jefferson, SD. On July 14, 2014, Steeg signed an admission to drinking alcoholic beverages on June 27th and July 10, 2014. Corey Steeg has failed to make any payments on his court ordered obligations.

Original Sentencing Synopsis:

Elk Point, S.D. – State's Attorney Jerry A. Miller said today that Corey Steeg, a 36 year old man from Sioux City, IA plead guilty on May 21, 2012 to one count of Possession of Controlled Substance, a class 4 felony and one count Driving with a Revoked License, a class 1

misdemeanor. Steeg was sentenced on June 25, 2012. For the charge of Possession of Controlled Substance, Steeg received a seven (7) year sentence to the South Dakota State Penitentiary with seven (7) years suspended. The Court then placed Steeg on five (5) years of supervised probation. Additionally, Steeg received a sixty (60) day sentence to the Union County Jail. For the charge of Driving with a Revoked License, Steeg received a fine of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars.

Case Synopsis of Probation Violation # 1:

The Court pronounced the following sentence on the charge of possession of a controlled substance, a class 4 felony, in which Corey Steeg would serve a suspended seven (7) year sentence with a requirement that Steeg must successfully complete a four (4) year term of supervised probation. Corey Steeg was also required to serve six (6) days in the Union County jail, of which Steeg received credit for the six (6) days he previously served prior to the final disposition of this file. Steeg was further ordered to pay all outstanding financial obligations, as well as any new obligations.

Criminal History Synopsis:

This is Corey Steeg's first probation violation on this felony charge and Steeg's third felony convictions on his permanent criminal record.
