Case Synopsis:

Joshua Schultz was sentenced and ordered to report to the Teen Challenge program in Brookings, SD as part of Schultz's sentence and probation. Schultz went to Iowa and was subsequently arrested on an Iowa warrant. Schultz spent time in the Iowa penitentiary and once he was released he failed to reconnect with his probation officer or to engage in the Teen Challenge program. Schultz admitted to violating his probation and was resentenced.

Sentencing Synopsis:

Joshua Schultz received a two (2) year suspended sentence and placed on supervised probation for two (2) years. The Court decided that Schultz would be given an opportunity to prove that the time that he spent in the Iowa penitentiary served to rehabilitate him, and therefore gave him an opportunity on supervised probation. This sentence is consecutive with the sentences of 11-440 and 11-441. The court further ordered that Schultz to pay all, restitution, fines, court costs, prosecution costs, and court-appointed attorney fees.

Criminal History:

This appears to be Joshua Schultz's seventh (7th) career felony conviction. This is Joshua Schultz's first probation violation on this felony offense.
