Case Synopsis:

Alan Stokley was arrested on September 8, 2013. Alan Stokley attended the wedding and reception of his stepson and his new wife, the son of his wife, Pam Stokley, who used to be married to Chris Oberg. Pam Stokley and Chris Oberg were talking together during the reception when Alan Stokley returned from the bathroom and became jealous by observing Chris Oberg talking to Pam Stokley. Without warning, Alan Stokley blind-sided punched Chris Oberg knocking Oberg unconscious. Oberg sustained medical bills of Three Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy-six Dollars and thirty-eight cents (\$3,576.38). Oberg sustained Six Hundred and Twenty-seven and sixty-one cents (\$627.61). Oberg sustained facial and nasal fractures, and continues to suffer from headaches and dizziness.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of Simple Assault, Alan Stokley received a sentence that required Stokley to serve sixty (60) days with forty (40) days suspended in the Union County jail with work release. The court further ordered that Stokley pay all, restitution (as stated above), a fine of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000), court costs, and prosecution costs.

Criminal History:

This is a class one misdemeanor conviction on Alan Stokley's criminal record.
