Case Synopsis:

This is Chase Luke's 2nd probation violation since he was convicted on the above-indicated crimes. Luke, while on probation, violated several time due to his behavior which resulted in a series of alcohol violations and marijuana use. The Court found that Luke had violated his probation.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of possession of a controlled substance Luke was resentenced and the Court revoked Luke's suspended imposition of sentence and sentenced Luke in the following manner. Luke was sentenced to a suspended seven (7) years sentence with five years supervised probation. Luke was ordered to serve 135 days in the Union County Jail with credit for the 15 days that Luke spent in custody awaiting the final disposition of the probation violation. The court further ordered that Luke pay all new court-appointed attorney fees.

Criminal History:

This is Chase Luke's second probation violation on his first felony conviction.
