Case Synopsis:

Officer Limoges of the Elk Point Police Department was called to the Haynie residence for a welfare check by a relative. The Department of Social Services was also called about Haynie's mental stability. The report to both agencies was concerned about his safety and his use of illegal substances. Officer Limoges identified, which was later admitted to by Haynie, that Haynie had attempted suicide through the ingestion of multiple over the counter and illegal substances. At the residence, Haynie was found to have multiple items of drug paraphernalia for different kinds of substances. Haynie plead guilty to Ingestion of a schedule 2 controlled substance and was sentenced on June 9, 2014. Haynie's urine tested positive for 575 ng/ml of Marijuana, and 1896 ng/ml of Methamphetamine.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of Possession of Schedule I or II Controlled Substance, Haynie received a five year suspended execution of sentence to the penitentiary and four years of supervised probation. Haynie was also ordered to pay all financial obligations as a condition of satisfying supervised probation.

Criminal History:

This is Michael Haynie's second career felony conviction.
