Case Synopsis:

On April 15, 2015 Trooper Heuertz observed Landerman driving 81 mph in a 75 mph zone. Upon first contact with Landerman, the strong odor of marijuana was obvious to the trooper. Landerman admitted to the possession of marijuana. Upon a search of the vehicle, Xanax pills were found which he admitted that he had purchased for his own use from a friend. Landerman also admitted to smoking marijuana two-hours prior to the stop of the vehicle. Landerman submitted a urine sample, which tested positive for marijuana (THC) at 992 ng/ml.

Sentencing Synopsis:

The Court ordered Landerman to complete one-year of supervised probation. The Court further ordered that Landerman pay the following:

- \$10.00 in Prosecution Costs;
- \$104.00 in Court Costs;
- \$45.00 to the SD Drug Control Fund;
- \$750.00 in fines; and
- \$450.00 in Court Appointed Attorney Fees.

Criminal History:

Dylan Landerman received a suspended imposition of sentence on this file from the Court. In the event that Mr. Landerman successfully complete his supervised probation this file will be sealed and pursuant to statute, Landerman may legal state to any person and / or entity that he has never been convicted of a felony. However, if Mr. Landerman violates his probation, and the court revokes his suspended imposition of sentence, the court could then enter a judgment and sentence.
