Case Synopsis:

On February 1, 2015 Jamie Herfel gained entry into the Skyline bar in North Sioux City by breaking the glass out of the back door. Once inside, cameras recorded Herfel finding the keys to the lottery machines and going through several of them. Cameras also recorded Herfel rummaging through drawers, moving casino machines, and tampering with a establishment's safe.

Sentencing Synopsis:

The Court ordered in each charge, a sixty-day suspended sentence with a requirement of no like offenses for three hundred and sixty day term of un-supervised probation.

The Court further ordered that Jamie Herfel to pay the following within one hundred and eighty days:

- \$10.00 in Prosecution Costs;
- \$84.00 in Court Costs on each charge (\$168.00 in Court Costs);
- \$300.00 in fines on each charge (\$600.00 in fines);
- \$447.74 in restitution to the Skyline Bar & Casino, and
- Court Appointed Attorney Fees in the amount of \$414.00

Criminal History:

Jamie Herfel received two misdemeanors in this file, however, he does have two felony convictions out of Nebraska dealing with a burglary and theft by unlawful taking charges stemming from a 2015 incident.
