Case Synopsis:

After Joshua Schultz's first probation violation, he was sentenced and ordered to report to the Oxford House Program for six months in Sioux Falls, SD as part of Schultz's sentence and terms of probation. Schultz failed the Oxford House program, violated the terms and conditions of probation, and failed to pay his monetary financial obligations. Schultz was arrested and brought before the court on this and two other felony violations to answer for his failure to comply with his terms and conditions of probation. On each of the felony files, Schultz admitted to the violation of probation.

Sentencing Synopsis:

Joshua Schultz's previous ten-year suspended sentence with ten-years supervised probation was replaced with a flat sentence of thirty-one days in the Union County Jail with credit for the thirty-one days previously served. The Court ordered the following:

- Schultz was ordered to pay Court Costs, Prosecution Costs, and Fines in the amount of \$614.00;
 - Schultz was further ordered that he would sit out the \$614.00 at \$60.00 a day for an additional ten days of incarceration in the Union County Jail.
 - Schultz shall be released from probation unsatisfactory upon the completion of his Union County Jail sentence.
- \$405.90 of old Court Appointed Attorney Fees have been converted to a civil judgment.

Criminal History:

This is Joshua Schultz's ninth (9th) career felony conviction. This is also Joshua Schultz's second probation violation on this felony offense.
