Case Synopsis:

On June 24, 2015 Shawna Roby, along with Ashleigh Fontana, and Charles Shavies III, participated in a scheme to use a set of false identifications and false credit cards to secure \$5,000 from Liberty National Bank in North Sioux City. Their fraudulent act was successful. Bank officials became suspicious when Ashleigh and Shawna both came into the bank and attempted a second cash advance on the second set of false identifications and false credits. All three suspects were arrested by the North Sioux City Police Department. Multiple false identification and false credit cards were discovered. Additional items and ledgers indicate that the three subjects were traveling the country conducting the same scheme.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of Grand Theft by Theft, Roby received an eighteen-month sentence to the South Dakota State Penitentiary. The Court further ordered that Fontana must pay the following:
The Court ordered Fontana to pay the following:

- \$10.00 in Prosecution Costs;
- \$104.00 in Court Costs.

On the charge of Possession of Known Forged Instrument, Roby received an eighteen-month sentence to the South Dakota State Penitentiary concurrent to the sentence issued by the court for the charge of Possession of Known Forged Instrument. The Court further ordered that Fontana must pay the following:

The Court ordered Roby to pay the following:

- \$104.00 in Court Costs, and
- \$1,215.54 in Court Appointed Attorney Fees

Criminal History Synopsis:

This is Roby's first career felony conviction. In the past, Roby has been charged with several felony offenses, which have been either dismissed or reduced to misdemeanor offenses. Roby is also either wanted or under investigation in other jurisdictions.
