### Case Synopsis:

Three North Sioux City casinos reported receiving counterfeit Twenty-dollar bills. The North Sioux City Police Department and the managers of the three establishments were able to identify Amber Grage as one of the individuals in the group that was passing the counterfeit money.

### Sentencing Synopsis:

The Court sentenced Amber Grage following her admission to the charge of Misprision of a Felony with a suspended ninety-day sentence to the Union County Jail. The Court further ordered that Amber Grage to pay the following:

- \$84.00 in Court Costs;
- \$111.24 in Prosecution Costs;
- \$300.00 in fines; and
- \$1,908.84 in Court Appointed Attorney Fees.

### Criminal History:

Amber Grage admitted to a concession charge of Misprision of a Felony from the passing of counterfeit \$20.00 bills.
