Case Synopsis:

On February 13, 2015 Trooper Cody Jansen observed a vehicle driving 80 mph in a 75 mph zone. Occupants in the vehicle was Corey Sprinkel, Marlitto Burnley, and Cody Walker. The driver was identified as Corey Sprinkel. Upon first contact with Sprinkel, the strong odor of marijuana was obvious to the trooper. Sprinkel was searched and a pipe containing marijuana wax. The search of the vehicle admitted to the possession of marijuana. Upon a search of the vehicle, the following items were seized as evidence:

- Bag with 13.4 ounces of Marijuana in a vacuum sealed bag;
- 1 pound 5.3 ounces of Marijuana wax in a vacuum sealed bag;
- 15 grams of Methamphetamine in a plastic bag;
- 2 oz. container of Hemp Oil
- .0625 of marijuana wax; and
- E cigarette with marijuana wax

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of Possession of Marijuana with the Intent to Distribute, the Court sentenced him to serve a suspended five-year sentence with a four-year term of supervised probation. The Court further ordered that Sprinkel pay the following:

- \$119.00 in Prosecution Costs;
- \$104.00 in Court Costs;
- \$155.00 to the SD Drug Control Fund;
- \$500.00 in fines; and
- \$1,204.65 in Court Appointed Attorney Fees.

On the charge of Possession of a Schedule 1 or 2 Controlled Substance, the Court sentenced him to serve a suspended five-year sentence with a four-year term of supervised probation. The Court further ordered that the sentences would run concurrent to each other. The Court further ordered that Sprinkel pay the following:

- \$104.00 in Court Costs;
