Case Synopsis:

On November 30, 2014, Deputy Josh Westcott was responding to a possible drunk driver heading north to the Beresford area on I-29. A Beresford officer located the vehicle in town. The driver was obviously intoxicated upon first contact. The driver was identified as Jason Flowers. The officers observed blood shot eyes, and slurred speech. During the contact, Flowers admitted that he was intoxicated and asked the officer to 'just take him to jail'. Jason Flowers provided a blood sample that tested positive for alcohol at a level of .271% by weight. The legal limit is .08% before a person is presumed by law to be under the influence.

Sentencing Synopsis:

As to count 1A, DUI 4th, a class 5 felony, the Court ordered a five-year suspended sentence with a three-year term of supervised probation. The Court also ordered a ninety-day sentence in the Union County Jail to begin immediately.

The Court further ordered that Jason Flowers pay the following:

- \$100.00 in Prosecution Costs;
- \$104.00 in Court Costs; and
- \$500.00 in fines.

Criminal History:

This is Jason Flower's fourth career felony conviction.
