### ORDER TO REVOKE SUSPENDED SENTENCE

REASON: Failure to pay financial obligations within 120 days

### Case Synopsis:

Ms. Old Lodge was in a vehicle with Anthony Pewo on January 25, 2013 when Pewo drove his vehicle into the ditch at mile marker 31 on Interstate 29. Pewo left Old Lodge in the vehicle and walked up to the Interstate to find someone to assist them. Union County Deputy, Thomas Moore, responded to the vehicle assist and discovered that Mr. Pewo was too intoxicated to be driving. Pewo, alleged that there was a third person in the vehicle that was the driver who had also walked away from the vehicle and had not returned. Deputy Moore documented that there were only one set of tracks in the snow leading away from the vehicle. Pewo was arrested and gave a false name and date of birth throughout the arrest process. Ms. Old Lodge picked up on the fact that Pewo was using his brother's first name and did not report this to Deputy Moore. Pewo went through the booking process and signed several documents with his brother's name and date of birth which were filed with the court, the county and with federal agencies. Pewo's forgery was discovered and Pewo was correctly charged and convicted of the Felony Forgery and the Felony Driving While Under the Influence offenses.

### Sentencing Synopsis:

Ms. Old Lodge entered a guilty plea to the Misprision of a Felony charge on October 7, 2013. Old Lodge was sentenced to serve a suspended sentence of thirty days in the Union County Jail on the conditions that all of her financial obligations were paid within 120 days of sentencing. Old Lodge was ordered to pay a fine in the amount of \$700.00; Court Costs of \$84.00; Prosecution costs of \$10.00; Court Appointed Attorney Fees of \$268.80. Deputy Moore was the original officer on this file. Deputy Jon Feller did the follow up investigation which resulted in Old Lodge's arrest and subsequent conviction.

**Disposition of the Court:**

On April 27, 2015, the Court found that April Oldlodge violated the terms and conditions of here probation. The Court ordered that Oldlodge shall serve 26 of the 120 days that the Court originally suspended. The Court gave Oldlodge credit for the 5 days she spent incarcerated prior the disposition of this action. The Court also for 16 of the days to be sat out at \$60.00 a day to pay for the following:

The Court further ordered that Vanessa Perez pay the following:

- Court Costs;
- Prosecution Costs; and
- Fines, all totaling \$960.00.
