Case Synopsis:

Trevor McCabe was arrested on May 10, 2015, following a crime spree in the Dakota Dunes area involving several vehicle burglaries. Through investigation, McCabe was found to have been with Collin Full, all of the Dakota Dunes area. Both McCabe and Full admitted to most of their actions. Property with the value of One-Thousand and Seventy-Five Dollars was recovered. While the two admitted that none of the items listed as stolen was theirs, the investigation was unable to identify a victim for all of the items. Because of this, and in spite of the extensive investigation, the State had to proceed with charges that were consistent with the files that were solved and know to law enforcement. A superseding information and complaint was filed which downgraded count 1 to a class 1 misdemeanor.

Sentencing Synopsis:

Trevor McCabe requested and received a suspended imposition of sentence in this file on the three charges that he admitted to. This is a once in a life time option available to a defendant. Through this sentence, if McCabe satisfies his 360 day un-supervised probation, his file will be sealed. Pursuant to statute, a defendant that receives this type of sentence would be able to state official on job application and so on that he or she has never been arrested and / or convicted for the offense or offenses that were covered within this file. Part of McCabe's terms and conditions for qualifying for this file to be sealed will require McCabe to pay all of his restitution and other financial obligations, as well as, obey all federal, state, and local laws.

Criminal History Synopsis:

Trevor McCabe does not have a felony record as such a record would make him ineligible for suspended imposition of sentence which the court granted in this file.
