Case Synopsis:

This case involves Brendon Reed stealing the checkbook of a friend that he would occasionally stay with in Nebraska. Reed used checks on several occasions from his friend's stolen checkbook to gamble in North Sioux City. Reed wrote several checks totaling \$1,584.60. North Sioux City police officer reviewed the video footage from the gambling establishments and was able to positively identify that Brendon Reed was the person who passed the closed account checks. Brendon Reed used the closed checkbook to secure cash by deception.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of Grand Theft by Deception, a class six felony, the Court sentenced Reed to a two year suspended sentence to the penitentiary and placed on supervised probation for a term of two years. The Defendant's sentence shall run consecutive to his sentence in file 15-414. Reed was further ordered to pay all of his financial obligations in full as part of his obligations to be successful on his supervised probation.

Criminal History Synopsis:

Between this file and file 15-414, this is Brendon Reed's third and fourth career felony conviction within the past fifteen years.
