Case Synopsis:

On March 28, 2016 at about 7:25 a.m. Trooper Trent Heuertz observed a vehicle traveling at rate of 90 mph in an 80 mph zone. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Joseph Zoellin. Zoellin was on his way to Elk Point, SD for court to be sentenced on another felony matter. Zoelin also had Aderall in his possession at this time as well. Zoelin stated that he had a prescription for the Aderall. Trooper Heuertz called the pharmacy identified by Zoelin and it was determined that Zoelin did not have a valid prescription.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge of Possession of a Controlled Substance, a class five felony, the Court ordered that Zoelin serve ninety days in the Union County Jail. The Court then suspended sixty days of that sentence. Zoelin was ordered to pay all of his financial obligations by April 28, 2016. The Court ordered that Zoelin pay \$104.00 in Court Costs, and \$500.00 in fines. The Court further ordered that Zoelin sentence shall run concurrent to his sentence in file 16-005.

Criminal History Synopsis:

This is Joseph Zoellin's second felony offense.
