Case Synopsis:

On April 17, 2015, at about 7:28 p.m., Officer Derek McIntosh responded to the Dakota Valley School to take a report from a school employee. The employee / victim reported that her credit card had been stolen. The victim advised that she discovered unauthorized charges on her statement. A call to the vendors revealed the address of the person who made the unauthorized purchases. The investigation took Officer McIntosh to Caleb Stanek's residence. Stanek admitted to the theft of the credit card and the unauthorized purchases. Stanek provided a urine sample which tested positive for marijuana (THC) at 1,388 ng/ml.

Sentencing Synopsis:

On the charge in Count 1, for Criminal Trespass, which is a class one misdemeanor, the Court sentenced Caleb Stanek with a suspended 180 day sentence to the county jail, under the terms and conditions that Caleb Stanek successfully complete a one year term of supervised probation. Caleb Stanek was ordered complete several terms and conditions, which include that Stanek paying the following: Caleb Stanek was ordered to pay \$84.00 in Court Costs; and \$300.00 in fines.

On the charge in Count 2, for Ingestion, which is a class one misdemeanor, the Court sentenced Caleb Stanek to pay \$84.00 in Court Costs; \$371.00 in fines; \$45.00 to the SD Drug Control Fund. Caleb Stanek was ordered to pay all monetary obligations by February 17, 2016.

Criminal History:

Caleb Stanek was originally charged with a felony charge of Identity Theft. This case was resolved with a conviction of two class one misdemeanors.
