### Case Synopsis:

On July 26, 2016, the vehicle that Jesse Giblin was driving was stopped because it did not have two license plates on the vehicle. During the traffic stop GIBLIN admitted that he used marijuana about one month ago. GIBLIN exhibited eyelid tremors. When asked, GIBLIN gave permission to the trooper to search is vehicle. During the search officers found marijuana, burnt marijuana, drug paraphernalia, and marijuana wax. GIBLIN was arrested for the above charges.

### Sentencing Synopsis:

On October 24, 2016, the Court addressed the class 1 misdemeanor charge in Count 2, for Possession of Marijuana. The Court sentenced GIBLIN to serve 30 days in the Union County Jail. GIBLIN was ordered to not have any like offenses for the next 180 days. GIBLIN must pay the following monetary obligations by December 1, 2016: \$84 in Court Costs; \$54 in fees to the SD Drug Fund; and a fine in the amount of \$300. GIBLIN's was further ordered to pay \$276 in Court-Appointed Attorney Fees.

The Court addressed the class 2 misdemeanor charge in Count 3, for Possession of Marijuana. The Court sentenced GIBLIN to serve 30 days in the Union County Jail. GIBLIN was ordered to not have any like offenses for the next 180 days. GIBLIN must pay the following monetary obligations by December 1, 2016: \$66 in Court Costs; and a fine in the amount of \$100.

**Criminal History:**

This felony case was resolved with a plea to two misdemeanor charges in GIBLIN's case. GIBLIN's previous criminal file includes three convictions for possession of marijuana; and one conviction for reckless driving.
