### Case Synopsis:

The Beresford police investigated a case in which a local Beresford resident was experiencing unauthorized charges on his account. It was determined that the victim had purchased an item from PICK. It was determined that PICK took the routing numbers off of the check and used those routing numbers to set up automatic payments that benefited PICK. Multiple accounts were paid over a couple of months until the unauthorized transactions were noticed.

### Sentencing Synopsis:

On November 18, 2016, the Court addressed the class 6 felony charge of Identity Theft. The Court sentenced PICK to a suspended two-year sentence to the South Dakota State Penitentiary and three years of supervised probation. The Court also ordered that PICK spend 26 days in the Union County Jail, and the Court then gave PICK credit for the 21 days PICK spent incarcerated prior to sentencing. It was further ordered that PICK must pay the following: \$104 in court costs; \$64.60 in prosecution costs; \$2,500 in restitution to the victim; \$2,549.98 in restitution to First Savings Bank in Beresford; and court-appointed attorney fees in the amount of \$501.05. The Court ordered that PICK shall make a minimum amount of \$100 towards her financial responsibility.

### Criminal History Synopsis:

This is PICK's first career felony conviction.
