Original Case Synopsis:

Kellee Julian failed to appear for her initial appearance in court on January 8, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. This was the date and time set for her to appear, and she was given notice of her court appearance.

Original Sentencing Synopsis:

Julian will pay \$104 to the Clerk of Courts for her felony charge. She was also placed on probation for 360 days, and the state suspended the imposition of sentence. Julian also must serve 96 days in the County Jail as a condition of a suspended imposition, deferment or execution of sentence. Specific dates to be arranged with a court services officer. 36 days of jail time are credited against the amount imposed. Julian must also pay \$600 in restitution to victim, \$156 to Union County, to be paid in 180 days, and \$469 to HR Construction. Julian shall work with the State in prosecution of co-defendant and shall call the State's Attorney's office every Friday until the prosecution of co-defendant is finished.

The conditions of Julian's probation are as follows:

1. CAAF, HE/SHE SHALL REPAY THIS COUNTY FOR ALL OF THEIR COURT APPOINTED ATTORNEY'S FEES TO THE UNION COUNTY AUDITOR. 06/12/2018, Active 06/12/2018
2. SUPERVISION, DURING THE PERIOD OF SAID PROBATION OR SUSPENDED SENTENCE, HE/SHE SHALL BE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE CHIEF COURT SERVICE OFFICER OF THIS CIRCUIT OR THE BOARD OF PARDONS AND PAROLES, AS THE CASE MAY BE, OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVES AND SHALL OBEY ALL OF THEIR RULES AND REGULATIONS AND ALL

CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY THEM EVEN THOUGH THEY MAY NOT HAVE BEEN SPECIFICALLY SET OUT BY THIS COURT. IF DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY COURT SERVICES, HE/SHE SHALL PARTICIPATE IN AND SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE HOPE COURT PROBATION. IF HE/SHE HAS FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS UNDER THIS JUDGMENT, THEY SHALL WORK OUT A PAYMENT SCHEDULE WITH THEIR PROBATION OR PAROLE OFFICER AND IF DEEMED NECESSARY BY THEM, SHALL EXECUTE A WAGE ASSIGNMENT FORM. 06/12/2018, Active 06/12/2018

3. OBEY ALL LAWS, HE/SHE SHALL OBEY ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL OR MUNICIPAL LAWS DURING THE TERM OF PROBATION OR SUSPENSION AND BE A GOOD LAW-ABIDING CITIZEN IN ALL RESPECTS. 06/12/2018, Active 06/12/2018
4. NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS, HE/SHE SHALL NOT USE OR POSSESS ANY CONTROLLED DRUGS OR SUBSTANCES INCLUDING MARIJUANA AND SHALL SUBMIT TO URINALYSIS, BREATH OR BLOOD TESTING AT ANY TIME REQUESTED TO DO SO BY THEIR PROBATION OR PAROLE OFFICER AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COSTS OF THAT TESTING. HE/SHE SHALL NOT ENTER ANY PREMISES LICENSED FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WHERE THE PRIMARY INCOME IS DERIVED FROM THE SALE OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE. HE/SHE MUST OBTAIN ANY MENTAL HEALTH OR SUBSTANCE ABUSE EVALUATIONS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY HIS/HER SUPERVISING AGENT/OFFICER AND COMPLY WITH THE RECOMMENDATIONS MADE PURSUANT THERETO AND REIMBURSE THE COUNTY FOR COSTS OF TREATMENT, IF APPLICABLE. 06/12/2018, Active 06/12/2018

CONTROL & JURISDICTION, THE COURT RESERVES CONTROL AND JURISDICTION OVER THE DEFENDANT FOR A PERIOD OF THE SENTENCE IMPOSED AND MAY REVOKE ANY SUSPENSION OR PROBATION AT ANY TIME AND REINSTATE THE SENTENCE WITHOUT DIMINISHMENT OR CREDIT FOR THE TIME THAT HE/SHE WAS ON PROBATION AND RESERVES THE RIGHT TO AMEND ANY OR ALL OF THE TERMS OF THIS SENTENCE AT ANY TIME. 06/12/2018, Active 06/12/2018

RIGHT TO APPEAL, THE DEFENDANT WAS ADVISED THAT HE/SHE HAS A RIGHT TO APPEAL FROM THIS JUDGMENT WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER IT IS SIGNED, ATTESTED AND FILED, THAT IF THEY WAIT MORE THAN 30 DAYS IT WILL BE TOO LATE TO APPEAL, AND THAT IF THEY ARE INDIGENT, THE COURT WOULD APPOINT AN ATTORNEY TO HANDLE THAT APPEAL FOR THEM. 06/12/2018, Active 06/12/2018
